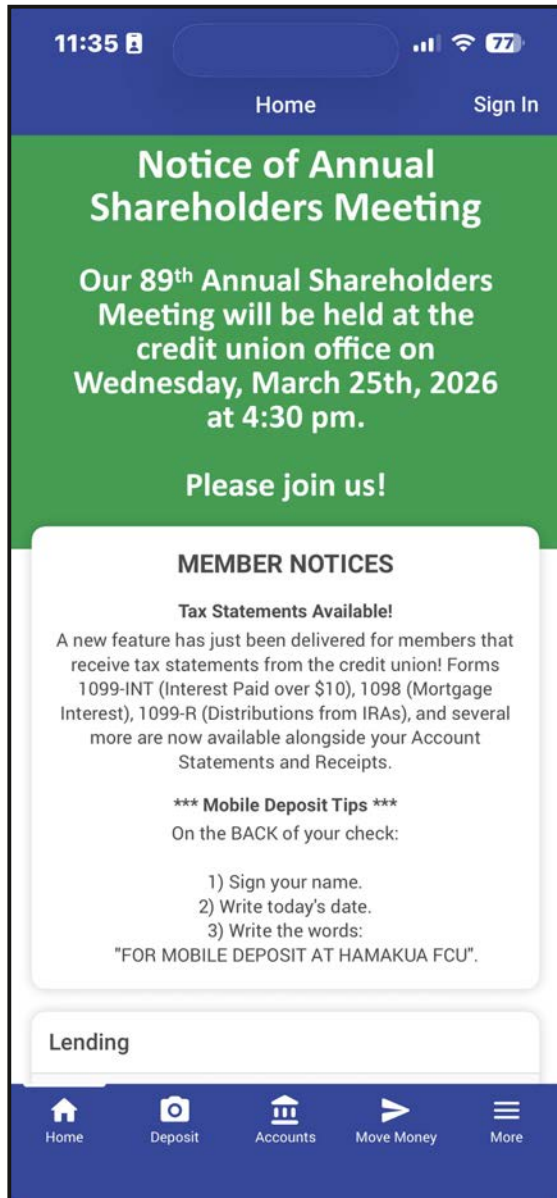

View and download 18 months of account statements, 3 years worth of transaction receipts and tax forms, and 6 years of loan documents.

Essentials of a Home Survival Kit

Battery or solar powered AM/FM radio.

Flashlights and Extra batteries.

First aid kit.

Prescriptions and over-the-counter medications.

At least 5-7 days supply of non-perishable foods.

Grill with charcoal and/or camping stove with fuel.

Manual can opener,

Matches or lighter.

Disposable plates and kitchen utensils.

At least one (1) gallon of water per person, per day for drinking, cooking, and hygiene. It is important to have available containers for water should service be interrupted. Ensure water containers are readily available. (To store water, use bathtub, rubbish containers, and washing machines for hygiene.)

Pet food if you have animals.

Generator and fuel.

***NOTE: The time to prepare your home survival kit
is before you need it.***
